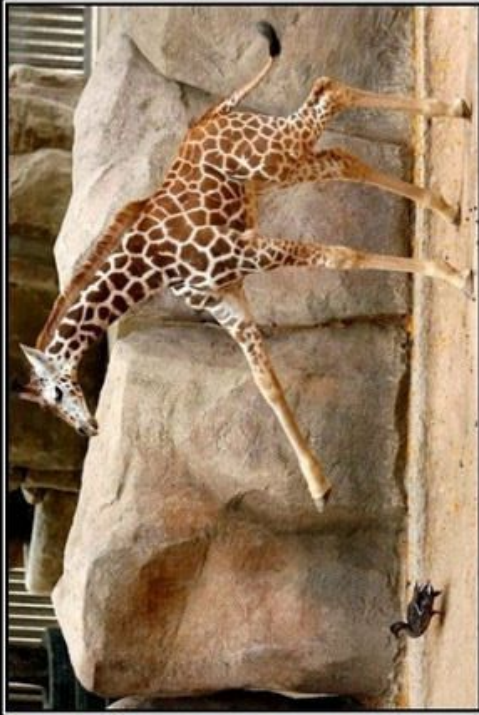

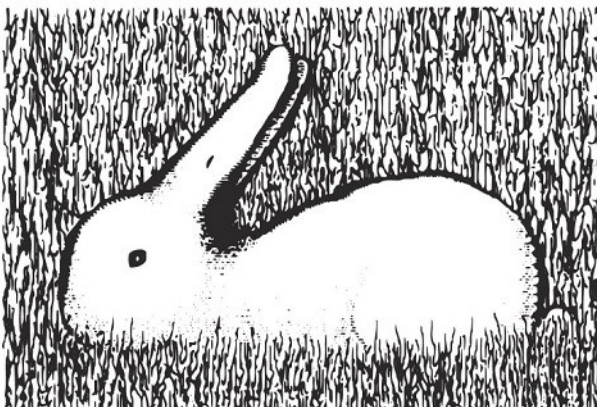

Tube time! Toilet paper tubes glued inside a box make the perfect hotel for small guests.



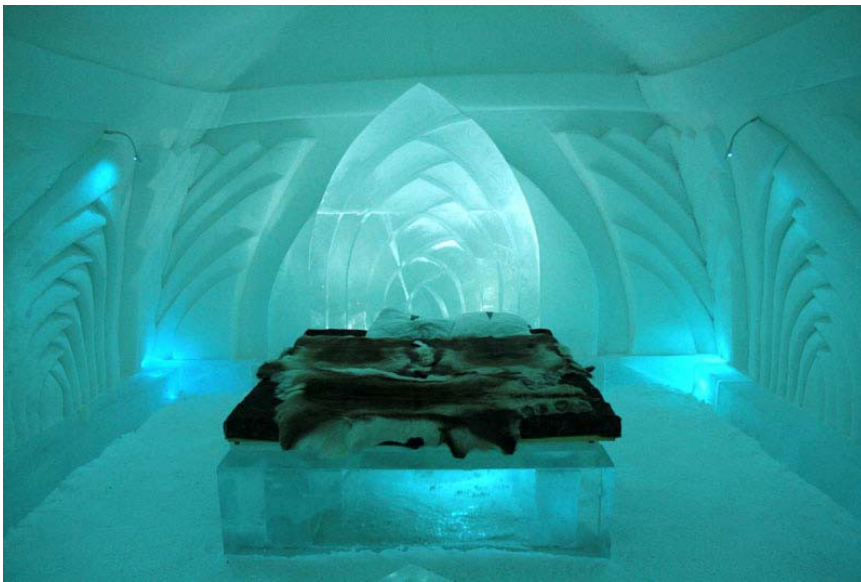

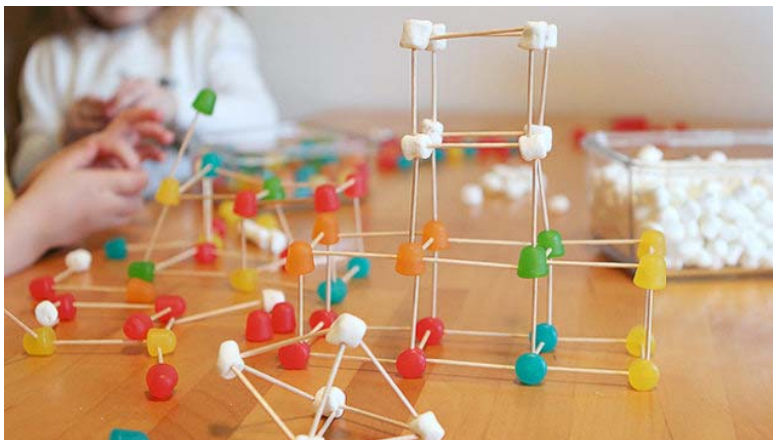

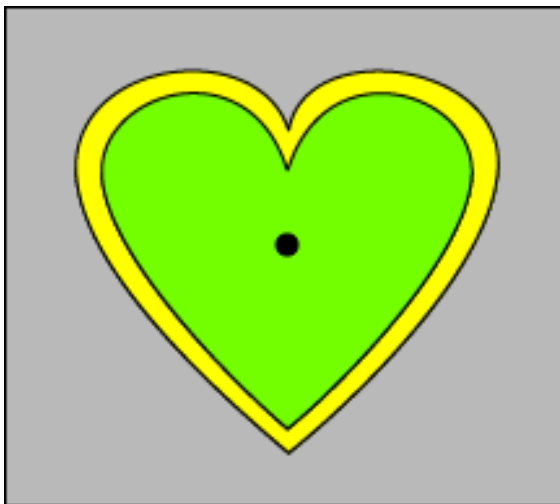
Candy architecture! Use toothpicks and gumdrops (or mini marshmallows) to build some different structures. Challenge yourself to build a super tall tower or a bridge!

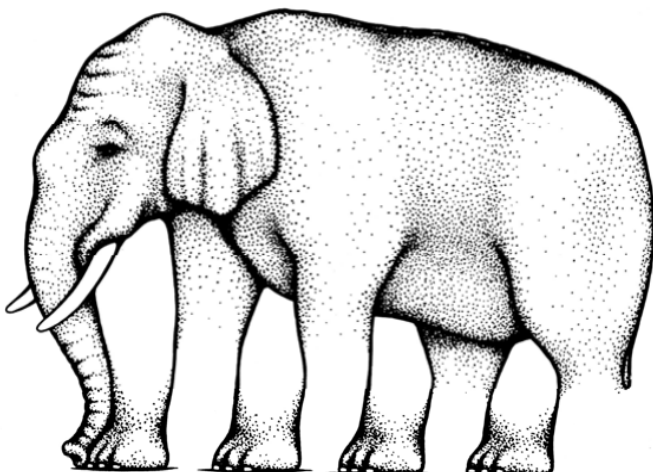
